

Classic Meeting Minutes, Nov. 19, 2024

1. Season recap for each team:

2014 Royals G (Coach Brent and Micheaux): Finished 8-2-0 (W-L-D) in 3rd Division West, earning promotion to Division 2 in Spring. 52 goals scored and 10 against. Also placed 2nd in the CCFC Classic in the 2013 Division. Royals got some really good contributions from several younger 2015s as well.

2012 Twisters G (Coach Meaghan and Jonas): Finished 8-1-3 (W-L-D) in 3rd Division West for a first-place finish, earning promotion to Division 2 in the Spring. Scored 27 goals with nine goals against. Managed to pull out two wins in the older division of the CCFC Classic before getting eliminated in the semi-finals via penalty shootout.

2011 Storm G (Coach Jonas, Jerry and Paige): Finished 8-1-3 (W-L-D) for a second-place finish in the 2nd Division West, becoming the first DCYSL team to make the jump to the first division. Scored 29 goals and only conceded three. Finished on a 10-game unbeaten run. Also won the championship at the Appalachian Classic in August.

2007 United G (Coach Kristine and Jason): Finished 3-2-1 (W-L-D) for a third place finish in 2nd Division West despite playing in the 2006 bracket. Also claimed second place at the CCFC Classic in August.

2014 United (Coach Jordan and Josh): Finished 5-4-2 (W-L-D) in the 3rd Division West, scoring 26 goals in what was the debut classic season for the majority of the team.

2013 Flight (Coach John and Lindsey): Finished 5-4-0 (W-L-D) for a 6th place finish out of 11 in the 3rd Division West. Ended the season on a 4-game winning streak. The boys also took home a second place finish at the Appalachian Classic.

2012 United (Coach Jacob, Johnny and Nicholas): Finished 9-2-0 (W-L-D) in the 3rd Division West for a potential first-place finish (waiting on another team's results), earning promotion to Division 2 in the Spring. United put up 40 goals in 11 games, only conceding 11 times. Team also advanced to the semi-finals of the Genesis cup in October.

2011 Wolverines (Coach Ashli and Jonas): Finished 4-3-0 with one potential game left to play for a fifth place finish out of 10. Scored 21 goals and conceded nine in seven games. A lot of new faces joined the team and stepped up big time in their classic debuts.

2. **Intent to Plays:** completed by Jonas on Nov. 18, confirm division placement for each team. Jonas will give payment details to Ashley (\$90 fee per team owed to NCYSA). Credit card or mail are the options.

3. **Budget snapshot:** We have \$82,136 in the Classic account as of Nov. 19. Upcoming expenses include Intent to play fees, uniform fees for U15 and U16 boys, ref fees for the Spring, tournament fees for the Spring, coaching and Director pay.
4. **Equipment needs:** U15 and U16 will need soccer balls, let's take advantage of the Black Friday deals upcoming. Several other teams will need a handful of soccer balls as well.

5. **Field usage:** We will continue to use Northwest Elementary and Reeds field throughout the Spring for practice, and possibly Oak Grove middle football field and Lexington Turf (confirm with Brent). Feel free to begin practicing around mid-February.
6. **Game fields:** We will likely use NW elem for U12 and under games, and we will need to decide between Oak Grove middle and Lexington for U13 and above.

Oak Grove has lights and clean restrooms. Lexington has lights and turf but the restrooms are unkept and there's usually trash everywhere. If we want to pursue Oak Grove, it's only an option in the Spring since there's no football. B.J. Harris (middle school A.D.) said we could use if we purchase goals for the school, thoughts?

7. **New age groups likely:** NCYSA is expected to change the age groups from birth year to calendar year (Sept. 1 to Aug. 31), so we need to prepare for some logistical challenges of forming the new teams. Making good use of dual carding players could be key.
8. **Tournament in Asheboro:** Classic is supposed to meet with Asheboro FC, possibly as soon as Nov. 21, to discuss co-hosting a tournament in March of 2025. Will update everyone.
